The terms "Buy American" and "Made in America" mean different things from the perspective of government regulators. The term "Buy American" refers to a bill that requires federal government spending to procure goods produced in America. As of Executive Order 14005, the "Buy American Act" requires a product to contain 60% America-made content. Goods that follow this standard can claim "Buy American Act Compliant."

The term "Made in America" is one of many claims that the FTC (Federal Trade Commission) regulates when used in advertising *all* goods. The FTC requires that "all or virtually-all" of the product to be produced in the USA in order to be labeled "USA," "Made in the USA," etc.

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THE BIPARTISAN INFRASTRUCTURE BILL

The 2021 Bipartisan Infrastructure Bill means that over the next few years, 1.2 trillion dollars will be spent on improving America's Infrastructure. When following the standards put forth in the "Buy American Act," this spending gives American manufacturing, steel, and iron preferential treatment. When consumers, retailers, and contractors buy, sell, and purchase products that meet the "Buy American Act," we each do our part in supporting our economic independence.



The "Buy America Act" was created in 1933 and signed by President Hoover requiring Federal Government spending to procure domestic materials and products.

The "Buy America Act" requires that all government purchases contain 60% of American-made steel, iron, or manufactured goods. Unless they are under the micro-purchase threshold of \$10,000 or no suitable product can be sourced within the United States.

THE RIGHT SIZE OF BAG

Whether you use one of our Wet+Dry Dustless Vac's or any other variety of shop vacuum, the Wunderbag's universal port will fit your vacuum. However, did you know the Wunderbag comes in different sizes for different capacity's of vacuum? Most shop vacuum port's range from 2" to 2 ^{3/4}" and easily are accepted by the Wunderbag's flexible gasket. Barrel sizes...

on the other hand are important to consider when you're shopping for bags. Using a bag that's too small will increase the chances that the bag will slip away from the port once the bag becomes weighted. Having too large of a bag can make the bag fold and crinkle, preventing you from maximizing air flow or obtaining maximum capacity.

To accommodate this, the Wunderbag currently comes in two sizes: 8-10 Gal. and 12-18 Gal. Both bags use the same universal port, but differ in dimensions. The 12-18 Gal. Wunderbag measures 40" long which comfortably wraps around the inner circumference of vacuum barrels such as our 16 Gal. HEPA Wet+Dry Dustless Vac. The 8-10 Gal. Wunderbag measures 27" long, which is better suited for smaller vacuums such as our 8 Gal. HEPA Wet+Dry PRO Dustless Vac. What size of vacuum do you have? Are you using the right size of bag?
